TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Scholarships will be granted once an unconditional offer of place has been issued.
- Scholarships are for enrolled students. Enrolment means fees paid, visa approved, arrival in New Zealand and studying the programme for more than three weeks.
- The student must not apply for a refund and students receiving scholarships must not apply for RPL/cross credits.
- Scholarships are subject to class capacity and programme availability.
- The Master of Applied Management full scholarship of \$5,000 will be applied only if full fees are paid. If the student is paying first year fees only, then a \$3,000 scholarship will be granted initially and the remaining \$2,000 when the student pays the remaining fees.
